How to Apply

Southwestern Academy accepts applications throughout the year provided space is available.

Schedule a campus tour: We invite you to schedule a campus tour of Southwestern Academy. While on campus, you'll tour the facilities, meet with students, faculty and administrators, and complete your interview with a member of the Admissions Team. Private campus tours are available Monday through Friday during school hours.

Schedule an interview: All applicants are required to schedule an interview as part of the admissions process. If visiting campus is not feasible during the application process, we welcome the chance to speak with you via Zoom.

Submit your application materials: Please use the Standard Application Online (SAO) to submit your application materials, including three years of transcripts, letters of recommendation, student/family information, and essays. **Our school code for SAO is 7430**.

A \$100 application fee is required to submit your application.

International Students

Southwestern Academy offers a full English Language Learners (ELL) immersion program. In addition to conducting an English assessment, our Director of Academics carefully evaluates the applicant's academic records and formulates a graduation projection plan. Through these combined processes, we can determine the most suitable curriculum for each student.

English Assessment: All students applying should submit English language test scores. Please reach out to the Admissions Office to further discuss which language assessment you have available. Additional in-house testing as needed.

Visa: The application for a Form I-20 will be provided once the student has been accepted and one half of tuition has been paid. International students under Southwestern Academy's student visa (F1) are required to live on campus in our boarding program.

Admission is based on selective criteria including: prior academic record, teacher recommendations, and standardized assessments. The admission committee will also consider evidence of the applicant's potential for success in a college-preparatory program.

Southwestern is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

Southwestern Academy is a nonprofit, nonsectarian school admitting students of any race, color, national and ethnic origin and sex to all rights and privileges, programs and activities. Southwestern does not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national and ethnic origin, or sex in the administration of its educational admissions, athletics, or other school-administered programs.
